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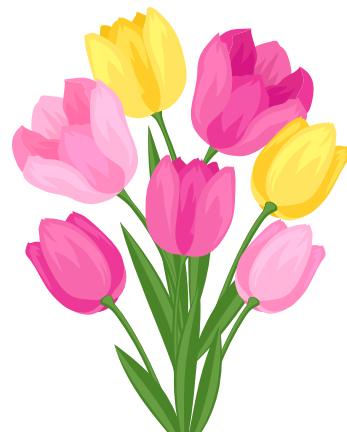

Occasionally Morann also enjoys coming out on the bus and having a change of scenery.

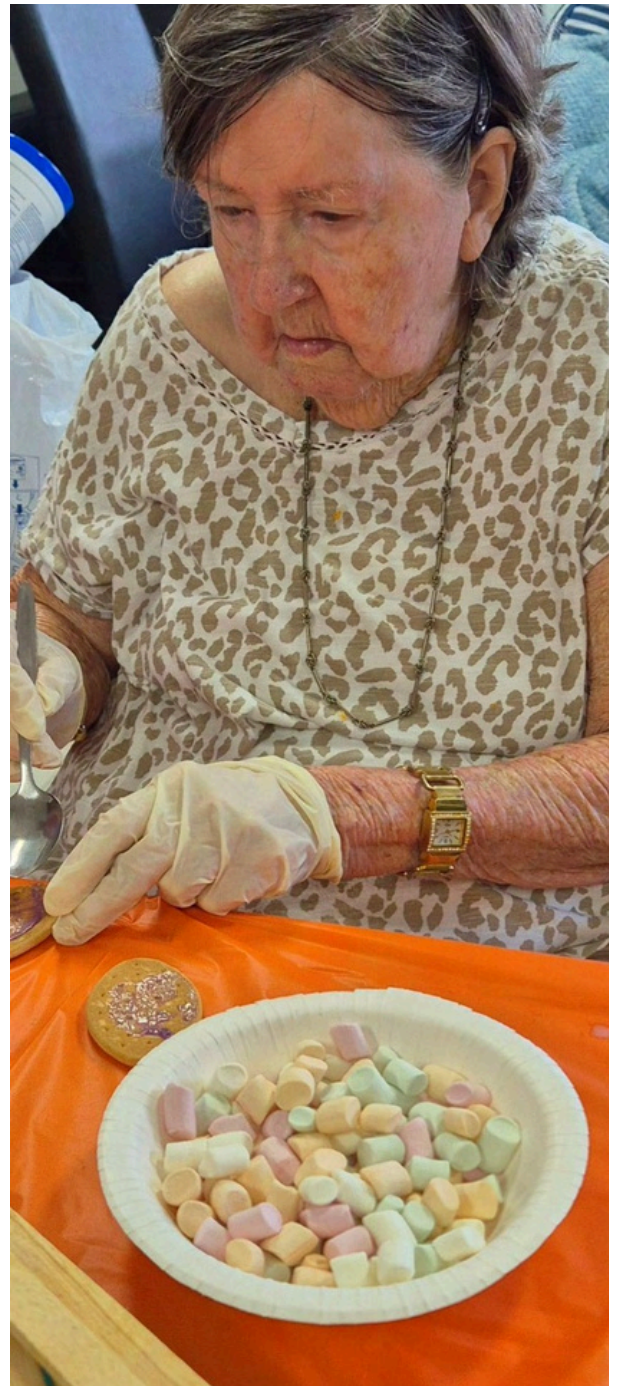
Morann's favourite colour is green, her favourite food is a stew and she loves Australian race car driver Peter Brock.
