The ladies have been working very hard on the Easter Bonnet hats for the Easter Parade. Sewing eggs, flowers, chickens and ducks to the hats.

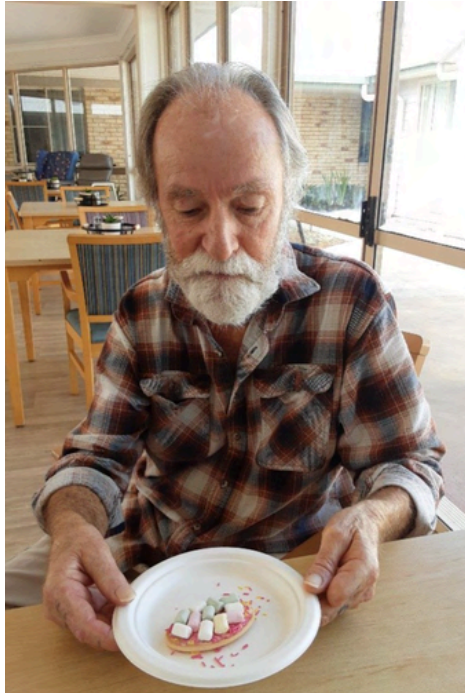
