Mal was born in Warragal, and enjoyed working as a farmer, a hospital operator, and on an oil rig as some of his many occupations.

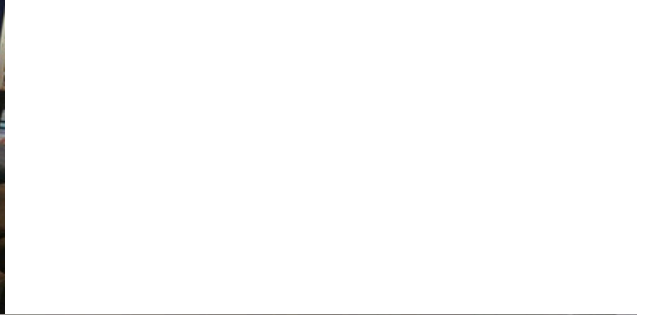

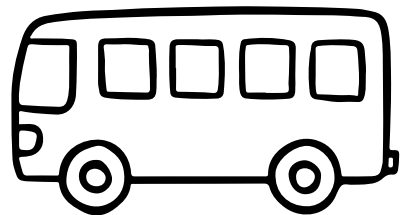

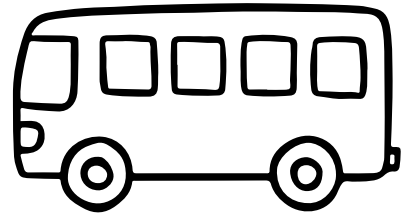
