Thank you all.

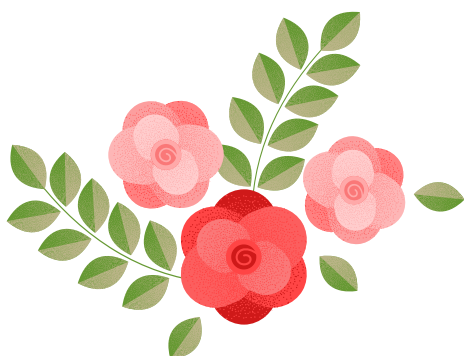
