Cindy enjoys spending time with her family.

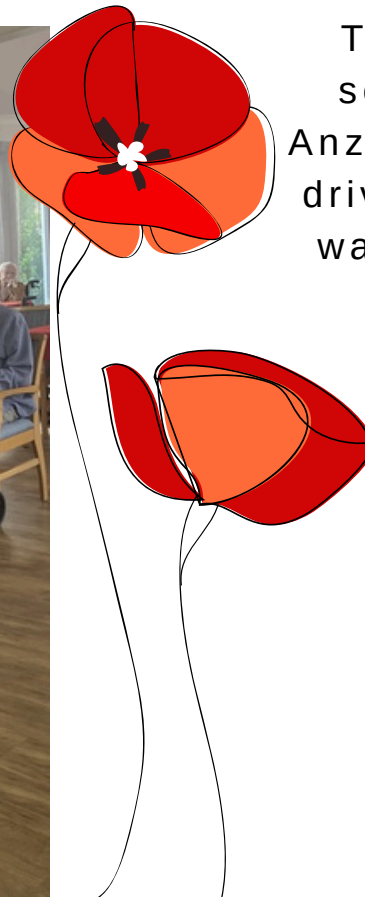

## RSL Service and Driveway Dawn Tribute



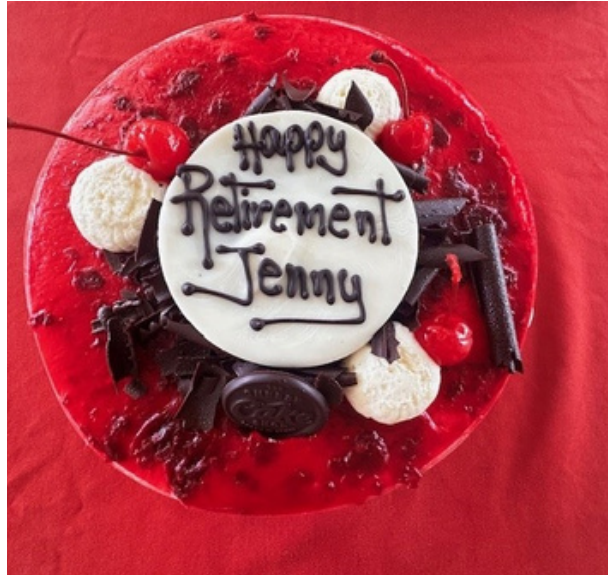

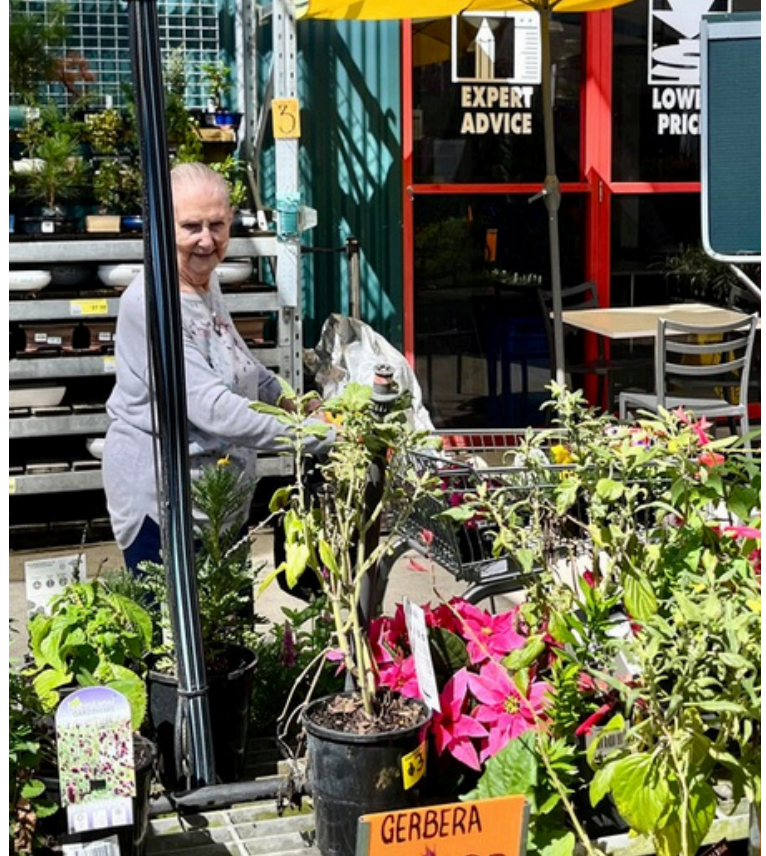
## MEN'S SHED

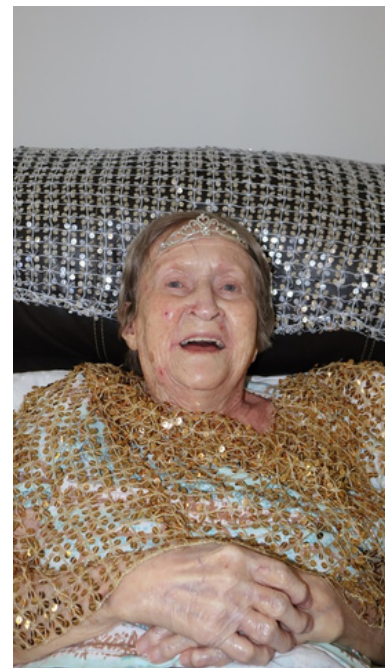
## GLAM SHOOT
