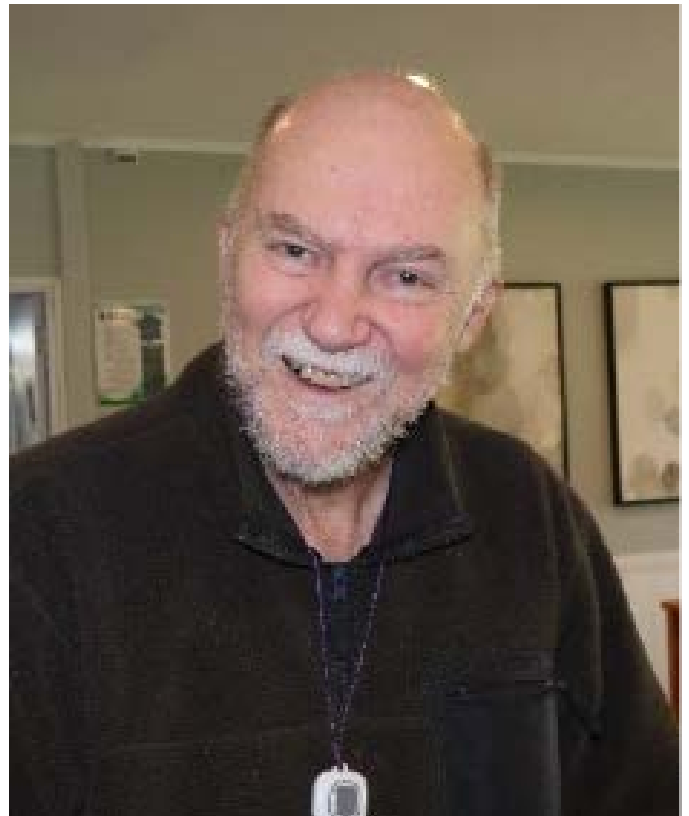
RESIDENT OF THE MONTH

Jesse says the best part of the role is being there for all of our residents, and what is most enjoyed about working at Beaumont Care is sharing a laugh with residents and brightening their day.

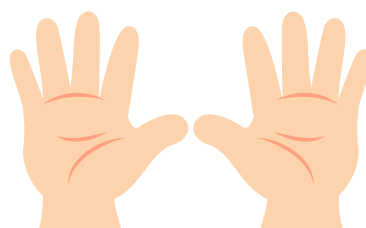

Please let the kitchen or administration know you would like a meal organised approx. 2 hours before scheduled mealtimes.

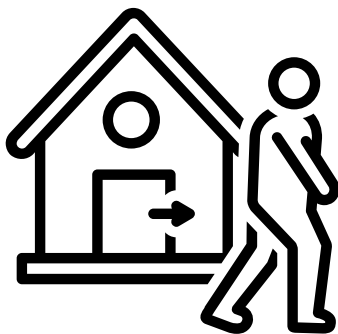
Next of Kin or relevant persons please alert staff if you; change your address, phone number, or contact details. We can then update your details.

Residents are welcome to use their own hairdresser at any time or go out to a private hair salon with family.

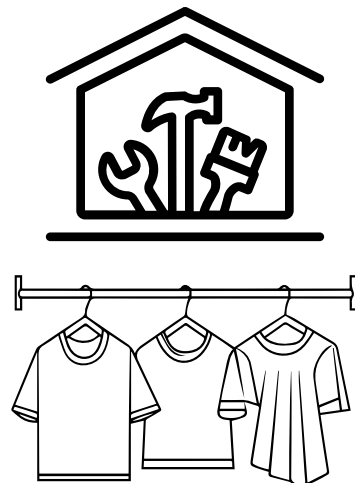


GOING OUT?
